PUBLIC MEETING: REGIONAL GREENWAY PLANNING GROUP/DOCTORS CREEK -ASSUNPINK TRAIL FEASIBILITY PROJECT

Allentown, NJ August 7, 2006

The Crosswicks/Doctors Creek Regional Greenway Planning Group announces a public meeting to present the progress of the Doctors Creek-Assunpink Creek Trail Feasibility Project at a public meeting on Tuesday, September 5, 2006.

The selected consultants for the project (Forbes Environmental & Land Use Planning and Borton-Lawson Engineering) will be presenting a host of information about the significance of the region and the Trail Feasibility Project, which traverses Hamilton, Upper Freehold and Millstone Townships and Allentown Borough.

When asked about the importance of this meeting, Betsy Poinsett, Chairperson of the Regional Greenway Planning Group responded, *We hope to enlighten the general public regarding the Crosswicks/Doctors Creek Watershed Regional Greenways Plan and will be receiving comments and recommendations on the trail feasibility, which will become part of our plan.*
