OLD BUSINESS

- Outdoor Wood burning Boilers – The EC gathered the same information that Committeeman Kinsey and Mr. Novello obtained from Monmouth County, State and Federal. We discussed and feel the EC is opposed to permitting anything like this and that these boilers were designed for remote areas with lots of space. We will send a formal letter to the Mayor and Township Committee. We also found that these boilers and their usage are hard to police.

- Water/Biological monitor testing training by Stony Brook Millstone Watershed Authority (Beth April) – Saturday, May 31, 2008 – time will be 9:00 a.m. to approximately NOON. The location to meet at 9:00 a.m. will be PNC bank parking lot at the corner of Millstone Road and Rt. 33.
- The computer moved upstairs for use by the EC now is connected to the internet.
- Update on permit for white plastic fencing on Millstone Road property by Benny Quagliarini – Mr. Quagliarini reports he discussed this subject with the Township and they are aware and are checking into the fence ordinance.
- Failed septics in Millstone Township – The Environmental Commission is doing research at the request of Mayor Grbelja on failed septic systems in Millstone Township. We will request any data that the Township may have from Jim Pickering. This may include the number of permits issued for new septic systems on existing homes, the number of failed septic systems, etc.
