- Outdoor Wood burning Boilers – a formal letter regarding our comments will be sent to the Mayor & Township Committeemen this week.
- Water/Biological monitor testing training by Stony Brook Millstone Watershed Authority (Beth April) – Saturday, May 31, 2008 – The EC thanks Doug Lischick for coordinating this event. A lengthy discussion followed. This is a very big project to undertake. Chairman Eric Davis will inquire if the Boy Scouts would like to do this testing. The second point as discussed with Mayor Grbelja was to reinstate the Watershed Commission and have them coordinate this project. The next date for testing is July 19 and then again in October. Board Secretary was instructed to put this item on the July meeting agenda for further discussion and solution.
- Update on permit for white plastic fencing on Millstone Road property by Benny Quaglierini – Mr. Quaglierini reports he discussed this subject

with the Township and they are aware and checking into the fence ordinance. The EC will draft a letter to the Mayor & Township Committee with copies to Jim Pickering and Pat Hynes with the EC's concerns regarding this fence pertaining to environmental issues.

- Failed septic systems in Millstone Township – The Environmental Commission is doing research at the request of Mayor Grbelja on failed septic systems in Millstone Township. Chairman Davis has contacted Michael Meddis of Monmouth County Health for information along with Jim Pickering. We have asked Mr. Meddis for information on the rate of failure of Septic systems in Millstone, the number of septic systems installed since Monmouth County took over and the number (%) of those that have failed. Also, the number of overall failures that Monmouth County has seen.
- Open unexpired position on the EC – Chairman Davis has approached a neighbor but no response to date.
