CHAIRPERSON REPORT – Eric Davis

Chairman Davis attended a seminar given by the EPA on Assessment Grants available from the federal government to municipalities for clean-up purposes. Vice Chairman Lischick will begin drafting a clean-up map based on the previous year’s clean-up. The stream clean-up flier will be available in late February.

The draft will be sent out to the Environmental Commission members prior to being sent to the Board of Adjustments.
