UPDATE FROM COMMITTEEMAN DORFMAN – Present

- The EC's request to increase members. No update on this, Committeeman Dorfman had questions. The EC will confirm in writing that EC requests the current ordinance defining the number of members be amended to include an additional alternate member rather than a regular commission member. This will allow the EC to include additional membership support without increasing the requirements to reach a quorum.
- Plan Review Timeline was discussed with Committeeman Dorfman. The EC typically will review drawings, formulate and submit comments to the Township within a 45-day period. As a result plan submittals deemed complete, will be required to be submitted to the EC at least 45 days prior to being heard by either the Planning Board or Board of Adjustment. This timeline will allow the EC to provide comment prior to the other boards hearing and approving plans without EC input. Such as the case with the plans for 512 Route 33 LLC. A letter will be sent to Committeeman Dorfman to bring back to Mayor & Township Committee that the EC needs a defined timeline sequence formalized.
