- Maximum allowed per household 5'X5'X5' should be placed curbside no later than 6AM on Monday, 4/7
- Hauler will have up to 04/12/14 to complete clean up, however hauler will only do **ONE** pass of each road
- Appliances, such as: refrigerators, washing machines, dryers and dishwashers will be picked up.

Note: All doors must be removed from refrigerators and freezers.

ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE PICKED UP:

- Items weighing over 200 lbs., rocks, stones, leaves, logs, brush, grass, slate, concrete, motor vehicles, tires, wheels, gas tanks, propane tanks, treated wood, metal pipe, barrels, recyclables, hazardous materials or liquid waste. Wood and materials must be 4' or less in length.
- Electronic Devices: (such as Computer Cases, CPU's, Keyboards, Mice, Monitors, Scanners, Printers, Cables, Laptops, Peripherals, Televisions, Radios, Telephones, Cameras, VCR's, DVD Players, Stereo Components).
- Wheels, metal pipe and barrels may be dropped off at salvage yards such as Beacon Metals in Freehold and Blewett Inc. in Howell.
- Propane tanks may be traded in at Home Depot, Lowes or Ace as long as they are equipped to fill tanks.
- Hazardous materials, paint etc. may be taken to the County Reclamation Center in Tinton Falls by appointment. For more information call 732-683-8686.



*** ATTENTION RESIDENTS * BRUSH DROP OFF**

As the extreme winter has caused more tree and shrub damage than usual we will be revising our brush removal procedures from prior years. As the volume of brush for many homeowners is well in excess of the 6' x6' x6' pile limitation and much of the brush is in excess of the 6" diameter, we will allow unlimited quantities and larger sized pieces (excluding briars, stumps, vines, leaves, grass or any other material) **to be dropped off at a central location at 15 Baird Road, across from Wagner Farm Park.** Residents will be required to provide proof of residency at the drop off location. This process will allow the Township to expand its service while more cost effectively servicing the residents in connection with the spring brush removal needs.

The Township will not have curbside pickup.

The Township is exploring opportunities with local volunteer groups to assist homeowners who may require assistance in transporting brush to the central location. Please contact the municipal offices for further details if you may require assistance. For homeowners with smaller amounts of brush, we encourage you to 'Go Green' and start a brush pile, which will degrade naturally to soil. Property Tax Reimbursement (Senior Freeze)

2013

Eligibility Requirements*

You must meet ALL of the following requirements:

- You were age 65 or older as of December 31, 2012, or if under age 65, you were receiving Federal Social Security disability benefits as of December 31, 2012, *and* December 31, 2013;
and
- You have lived in New Jersey continuously since December 31, 2002, or earlier, as either a homeowner or a renter;
and
- You have owned and lived in your home (or have leased a site in a mobile home park for a manufactured or mobile home that you own) since December 31, 2009, or earlier;
and
- You paid the full amount of the 2012 property taxes due on your home by June 1, 2013, and paid the 2013 property taxes by June 1, 2014;
and
- Your total annual income for 2012 did not exceed \$82,880* and for 2013 did not exceed \$84,289.* **NOTE:** With very few exceptions, all income received during the year must be taken into account to determine eligibility (including social security, pension income, etc.)

* **Eligibility requirements, including income limits, and benefits available under this program may be changed by the State Budget. Any changes to the 2013 eligibility requirements will not be finalized until the completion of the State Budget that must be adopted by July 1, 2014.**






