Approval of Meeting Minutes: August 13, 2014

Resolution:

P14-10 Petrella/Barber - Block 29, Lot 49 located at 1 Old Oak Court consisting of 22,930 s.f. and Block 29, Lot 50 located at 18 Running Brook Lane consisting of 27,744 s.f. both located in the R-20 Zoning District. Applicants sought and received minor subdivision approval (lot line adjustment) with no new lots being created. Deemed Complete 7-24-14. Date of Action 9-7-14. No variances were requested. No noticing required. Application approved on 8-13-14. Approved application memorialized.

Extension of Time:

P 14-11 Perl Acres South - Block 55, Lot 2, - Located on Route 526. Previously Zoned R-130 consisting of 158.2 acres. Applicant received Preliminary Major Subdivision approval for a 43-residential lot subdivision and 2 lots for Township dedication received 6-25-03. STREETLIGHT ON THE BLINK?

Streetlights brighten up a community and help keep it attractive and safe. Help keep streetlights working as they should by letting JCP&L know when lights are in need of repair. If you see a streetlight out, please contact JCP&L so that repairs can be made.

To report a streetlight outage:

- Call the automated outage reporting line at 1-888-LIGHTSS (1-888-544-4877). For faster service, use the phone number associated with your account and say "streetlight problem" after the greeting.
- Visit www.firstenergycorp.com, and select Jersey Central Power & Light. Under Outages, click on "Report Streetlight Problems."

When you contact JCP&L, let them know the following:

- Your name and phone number, in case they need more information.
- Address where the streetlight is located - nearest house or business address and the nearest cross street.
- The number on the pole.
- What is wrong with the streetlight. For example: damaged pole, light fixture is broken, the light is on during the day, the light is out or the light flickers.





VETERANS DAY CEREMONY - Tuesday, November 11th

A Veterans Day salute to US military Veterans will take place at 11:00 a.m. (sharp) on Tuesday, November 11, 2014 at the Millstone Township Veterans Memorial. Following a brief ceremony, "Taps" will be played. The Millstone Veterans Memorial is located at 470 Stage Coach Road, next to the Municipal Building.

Following ceremonies, light refreshments will be served at the Millstone Township Community Center across from the Memorial. All Military Veterans, current serving military and citizens are invited to attend. A special "We Support The Troops" flag will be available for signing.

On November 11th, ceremonies will take place at Veterans memorials all across the US, at the exact hour- 11:00 a.m. In November 1918 during WWI, an Armistice was signed establishing a cease fire between the Allied and the German fighting forces. It was agreed that all opposing armies would silence their weapons exactly at 11:00 a.m. on November 11th.

Veterans Day is established in the US as a national holiday to recognize our nation's Military Veterans, past and present, and the sacrifices they've made to protect our nation.

The United States Military "Code of Conduct:"

I am an American, fighting in the forces which guard my country and our way of life. I am prepared to give my life in their defense.

I will never surrender of my own free will. If in command, I will never surrender the members of my command while they still have the means to resist.


If I am captured I will continue to resist by all means available. I will make every effort to escape and to aid others to escape. I will accept neither parole nor special favors from the enemy.

If I become a prisoner of war, I will keep faith with my fellow prisoners. I will give no information or take part in any action which might be harmful to my comrades. If I am senior, I will take command. If not, I will obey the lawful orders of those appointed over me and will back them up in every way.

When questioned, should I become a prisoner of war, I am required to give name, rank, service number, and date of birth. I will evade answering further questions to the utmost of my ability. I will make no oral or written statements disloyal to my country and its allies or harmful to their cause.

I will never forget that I am an American, fighting for freedom, responsible for my actions, and dedicated to the principles which made my country free. I will trust in my God and in the United States of America.




A Sign Is Worth a Thousand Words Project

The Millstone Environmental Commission, concerned about damage to the town's network of public trails and open space being caused by unauthorized motorized vehicles, obtained a grant from the Association of NJ Environmental Commissions (anjec.org) to help resolve the problem. In addition to environmental impacts such as soil erosion, sedimentation of streams, and contamination of soil with oil and gasoline, motorized vehicles present a safety hazard for walkers, bikers and horseback riders on the trails. The grant paid for 40 signs that were installed by the public works department, notifying park visitors of the Township's ordinance that prohibits the use of motor vehicles on Township open space, and asking the public to report any violations they observe.

Get Your Kids HPV Vaccine Now To Prevent Cancer Later

HPV is short for human papillomavirus. About 20 million people in the United States, most in their teens and early 20s, are infected with HPV.

Not only does HPV cause almost all cervical cancers in women, it is also responsible for other types of cancer. HPV has caused mouth and throat cancer, as well as anal cancer in both women and men. HPV can cause cancers of the vulva and vagina in women, and cancer of the penis in men. Each year, there are about 18,000 women and 7,000 men affected by HPV-related cancers in the United States.

Most of the HPV infections that cause these cancers could be prevented with vaccination.

HPV-related cancers can be devastating. Jacquelyn, a cancer survivor and mother of two preschoolers, shares her story. Soon after her second child was born, Jacquelyn was diagnosed with cervical cancer and needed a total hysterectomy. "My husband and I had been together for 15 years, and we were planning to have more children - that isn't going to happen now", says Jacquelyn.

Although they caught Jacquelyn's cervical cancer early, she still has medical appointments taking time away from her family, friends and work. "Every time the doctor calls, I hold my breath until I get the results. Cancer is always in the back of my mind".

"I will protect my son and daughter by getting them the HPV vaccine as soon as they each turn 11. I tell everyone to get their children the HPV vaccine series to protect them from these kinds of cancers".

HPV vaccines offer the greatest health benefits to individuals who receive all three doses before having any type of sexual activity. That is why HPV vaccination is recommended for preteen girls and boys at age 11 or 12 years.

HPV vaccines are given in a service of three shots over 6 months. It is very important to complete all three shots to get the best protection. More than 46 million doses of HPV vaccine have been given out, and vaccine studies continue to show that HPV vaccines are safe.

If your son or daughter has not started or finished the HPV vaccine series yet, it is not too late! Now is a good time to ask their doctor or nurse about vaccines for your preteens and teens. Visit www.cdc.gov/hpv to learn more about HPV and HPV vaccines.


