***** REMINDER TO RESIDENTS *****

**NUMBERING OF PROPERTY
Per Ordinance Numbers:
87-9, 91-14, 93-08, 00-06**

14-4.5 Specifications:

House or building numbers shall be:

- a. In Arabic numerals.
- b. A minimum height of three (3") inches.
- c. Mounted in a secure fashion to the front wall or porch of the building or other fixed appurtenance in the front of the building so as to be clearly visible from the street.
- d. Sufficiently legible as to contrasting background, arrangement, spacing and uniformity so as to be clearly visible from the street both day and night. Reflective numbers are mandatory.
- e. At least thirty (30") inches above ground level and so placed that trees, shrubs and other obstructions do not block the line of sight of the numbers from the street upon which the building fronts.

Alliance to Prevent Substance Abuse Launches New Media Campaign

Millstone residents will be seeing a lot of “red” over the coming months. That’s because of the re-launch of the nation-wide underage drinking prevention campaign:



Developed in 2000 by Ohio Parents for Drug Free Youth, the campaign objectives are to educate parents about the health and safety risks of serving alcohol at teen house parties and to increase awareness of and compliance with our underage drinking laws. Most parents don’t know that they can be held civilly liable on a variety of bases if they supply alcohol to minors and it results in injury to the minor, to third parties or causes damage to properties. The “Social Host” Law addresses the criminal and civil liability of the adult who provides the alcohol. In addition, Millstone Township has a Private Property Ordinance where juveniles can be fined for use of alcohol on private property.

According to a recent study by the Center for Alcohol and Addiction Studies at Brown University in Providence, R.I. some parents do believe in the “European model” - the idea that introducing kids to alcohol early, at home, will teach them about responsible drinking and lessen the “taboo” appeal of alcohol. However this study proved evidence to the contrary.

Youth perceive a mixed message when adults provide them with alcohol at a young age. They don’t hear that having a beer or some wine in a controlled setting is acceptable. They hear that it’s OK for them to drink anywhere, anytime.
