

**** REMINDER TO ALL RESIDENTS ****

**Township Code Book Chapter 3, Police Regulations, Section 3-26
Manufacturing, Selling, Transporting or Using Fireworks**

“Any person who shall manufacture, sell, transport or use fireworks, or permit the use of fireworks on premises under ones ownership or control, shall be adjudged in violation of this chapter. "Fireworks," as used herein, shall include any combustible or explosive composition, or any substance or combination of substances, or article prepared for the purpose of producing a visible or an audible effect by combustion, explosion, deflagration or detonation. Persons having ownership or control of premises at which fireworks have been used in violation of this subsection shall give rise to a rebuttable presumption to having permitted the use of fireworks on such premises. Such presumption may be rebutted by submitting evidence that such person took affirmative action to stop or prevent such use, or was not physically at or in close proximity to the premises at any time during such use. It shall be a defense to a charge hereunder if the person shall have been issued a permit by written resolution of the Township Committee pursuant to the provisions of the State Fire Prevention Code.”

Any person who shall violate any provisions of this Code shall upon conviction thereof, be punishable by one or more of the following: a fine not exceeding \$2,000.00 or imprisonment for a period not exceeding 90 days or community service not exceeding 90 days or a combination of the above.
