Kevin Bomba, 1 Whisper Spring Drive, spoke on behalf of Millstone Recreation Basketball, he addressed the commission members on the upcoming Summer basketball season

Summer Basketball

1. There is a possibility of a donation of a portable container at Abate Park for the storage of summer basketball equipment including 4 portable rims, canopies, tables, hoses and chairs in the coming months. Kevin Bomba stated the Girls Scouts as part of their Silver Award project would paint the container trailer so it would blend in to its surroundings and plant flowers at the base.
2. Questions as to the permanent placement of the trailer and the need for a concrete pad were discussed.
3. Kevin Bomba was asked to provide the dimensions and possibly a photo of the container for the Commission's review.
4. The information provided should include the quality of the trailer, size, its general physical condition and if it is water tight.
5. A rental container unit will be placed at Abate Park in June for the upcoming basketball season.
6. Mayor Kinsey discussed parking and would place a member of Dept. of Public Works or Code Enforcement for overflow parking if needed. No Parking signs have been placed and there is ample parking for all participants. Some nights the playing field is also used for Football which contributes to the parking issue.
7. Kevin Bomba will provide to Chris Morris the possible container specs for his review.
8. Reversible jerseys will be used again this season allowing coaches to move players from team to team in the pick-up style format.

9. The summer program is growing and has the strong support of many volunteers. The Commission thanked Kevin for his continued dedication to both the winter and summer programs.

Summer Camp

1. Vouchers are being received for camp trips. Trips will be released as soon as the final confirmations are received.
2. The commission was concerned that more new trips were not offer this year but Gary Conk , Camp Director had concerns regarding the safety of the areas some trips are offered as well as the distance to the trips would not allow adequate time at the trip venue.
3. The number of trip buses was reduced from 3 down to 2 to offer fewer options and to sell out the trips so buses run at full capacity.
4. The Commission asked that a satisfaction survey be sent at the end of camp.
