Agenda items:

Summer Camp - C/Morris was given an update of summer camp staff. Both Art and Computer room teachers have been secured. Many counselors are returning from last year. New counselor and CIT applications have been received and the director will be interviewing during the month of May. The commission spoke on possibly offering high school students the opportunity for community service. A few high school students are interested in giving small group instruction of different sports to the participants at camp. This will be discussed with camp director.

Lacrosse - C/Skowronski gave an update on the program. They are hosting their 3rd annual tournament on May 7th. They are expecting approximately 400 participants. Both girls and boys programs are doing very well, volunteers on the boys side are a little low. At the end of the season the Lacrosse board will discuss program guidelines and any changes they would like to implement before the next season.

Soccer - C/Simels stated soccer has begun and all coaches were in place. The numbers have increased from last year. Any cancellations due to weather and such would be made through the website. C/Simels would like to continue the discussion with the MUTS Organization. A future meeting will be scheduled.

Summer Basketball - C/DeFelice discussed the status of summer basketball. There are plenty of volunteers for the program. An online registration for volunteers was discussed and will be implemented on the website. A storage container will be placed at the park for items for the program to be stored.

Will be discussed with Tennis Instructor. There were also a few calls from residents outside of Millstone looking to sign up. The commission spoke briefly about the policy regarding residents that reside outside of Millstone.
