The Secretary updated the commission on the preparations for Holiday Lighting. The signs were being delivered and will be placed after the election signs are removed. Holiday gift program has also started and is working with the Moms Club of Millstone.

**New Business:**

The Chairman notified the Commission that he's received information regarding MUTS' budget information. There have been quite a few emails going back and forth. He will discuss and answer any questions that they have and hope to have this finalized at a later date.

Mayor Kinsey thanked the Commission, Pop Warner Board, Lacrosse Board, and all parents that attended the Township Committee meeting in support of Millstone Park.

The contract will be awarded in December and construction should begin as weather permits. Mayor Kinsey noted that he will keep the Commission up to date on the progress.

C/Peake updated the Commission regarding a Pop Warner Football team that is still competing. They have a playoff game the following weekend. The JV Cheer Team will be competing in Disney in December.

C/Skowronski spoke regarding the upcoming Lacrosse season. The board has been meeting to discuss registration and uniforms. They have all coaches in place and are looking for some new board members to start off the season. Would also like to introduce a travel team in the future.
