MEETING MINUTES

Meeting Called to Order by Chairman Morris at 7:32 p.m.

Reading of Adequate Notice by Chairman Morris.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: February 6, 2017

C/Peake made a Motion to approve and C/Russell offered a Second. Roll Call Vote: Simels, Peake, Skowronski, DeFelice and Russell vote yes to approve the minutes.

Chairman Morris opened to the public at 7:33 p.m.

Sean Kilcomons, a recreation basketball coach spoke to the Commission regarding the basketball season. He thanked C/DeFelice and the Recreation Department for all their hard work during the season. Mr. Kilcomons said everyone had a great time during championship weekend and the gyms were packed with spectators. Noticed many of the teams stayed to cheer on their friends. Chairman Morris appreciated his comments was glad to hear it was great season. C/DeFelice spoke about possibly extending the High School division and providing some gym time for pick-up games. Mr. Kilcomons agreed that if Recreation is able to provide gym time that he would volunteer to help supervise. C/Simels noted that years ago they had a similar program that was open to teens. The Secretary will look into gym time and discuss with C/DeFelice.

Chairman Morris closed the meeting to the public at 7:58 p.m.

Basketball:

C/DeFelice said overall is was a good season. Championship weekend the gyms were packed and games were all very close. They will make adjustments to the draft for next year. C/Simels asked about Summer Basketball. C/DeFelice stated it was opened in April last year. At this time they do not have volunteers committed 100%. C/ DeFelice noted that C/Adornetti is reaching out to some contacts to possibly facilitate the program.

Lacrosse:

C/Skowronski stated that formal practices are starting this week. They have many volunteers this year, 4-5 coaches per group. The Lacrosse Club donated a registration for next year's season. Lacrosse also offered a speed and agility class before the season with great attendance.

Soccer:

C/Simels spoke about a meeting with the MUTS (Millstone United Travel Soccer) and their board approved a merger with Millstone Recreation. C/DeFelice reviewed the budget with the board and have agreed on terms and the changes to the By-Laws.

Chairman Morris called for a Motion to adopt Millstone United Travel Soccer (aka MUTS) into Millstone Recreation.

C/DeFelice made a motion to adopt and C/Skowronski offered a second. Roll Call Vote: Morris, Simels, Peake, Skowronski, DeFelice, Russell vote yes to approve the Motion.

New Business:

C/Russell announced Millstone Day will be September 17, 2017 at Frogbridge Day Camp.

C/DeFelice asked if DPW could fix some of the S-hooks at Abate Park basketball courts. C/DeFelice would like to look into installing a lower basketball hoop for the younger kids at Abate Park and also changing out the rims on the current courts. Secretary will follow up with the Township Engineer and DPW.

Seeing no new business Chairman Morris asked for a Motion and a Second to adjourn the meeting. C/Peake made a Motion to Adjourn and C/Skowronski offered a Second and by unanimous vote, the meeting adjourned at 8:42 p.m.
