Lacrosse:

Summer Basketball:

There are currently 120 players registered for the session. Volunteers have been secured and are mostly coaches from the Winter season. The trailer has been moved to Abate Park to secure the equipment for the program.

Pop Warner:

C/Peake made a motion to adopt Referee/Clock Operator fees for Pop Warner Football games and C/Adornetti offered a second. Roll Call Vote: Morris, Simels, Adornetti, Peake, Skowronski, Russell, and Aprile vote yes.

New Business:

The secretary was contacted by the volunteer liaison for Field Hockey. She would like to make a couple changes to the program to secure more volunteers. The Commission agreed to the changes and registration will open in July.

C/Russell would like to implement a Home Run Derby for Millstone Day. C/DeFelice will also be running a basketball and volleyball tournament. Prizes will be given to 1st place for each age group. Once details have been discussed, the Recreation Office will begin to advertise.

Seeing no new business Chairman Morris asked for a Motion and a Second to adjourn the meeting. C/Adornetti made a Motion to Adjourn and C/Simels offered a Second and by unanimous vote, the meeting adjourned at 8:27 p.m.
