Meeting Called to Order by Vice Chairman Simels at 7:30 p.m.

Reading of Adequate Notice by Vice Chairman Simels.

Roll Call Vote:

DeFelice, Peake, Skowronski, Russell, and Casale vote yes to approve the minutes.

Vice Chairman Simels opened the meeting to the public at 7:30 p.m.

Victor Cappuzzo, a township resident in his junior year addressed the commission regarding his Eagle Scout project. Pop Warner:

Cheer coaches have submitted a request to host a cheer clinic during the Winter and Spring months at Wagner Farm Park. The Commission hopes that this will generate interest in the Pop Warner program.
