

**MILLSTONE TOWNSHIP PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION

**AGENDA ITEMS**

***PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR:***

C/Faber opens the meeting to the public at 8:02 p.m.

Arjun Shah (4 Georgeann Lane Clarksburg, NJ 08510) an Eagle Scout troop 116 returned with his revised plans for a sign at Wagner Farm Park. A one sided sign will be built at the entrance of Wagner; it will say "Home of the Millstone Eagles" across the top and an eagle will be placed in the center. Room at the bottom will be left for awards and placards. Recreation Secretary will draw up approval letter needed for next step of project.

Brian Walkley (15 Rockybrook Road, Millstone Twp, NJ) President of the Millstone Travel Soccer thanked the committee for the new bathrooms being built at Brandywine. He coaches about 400-500 recreation players and 200 travel players. He discussed preserving fields 1 and 2. Lacrosse uses 1 and 2 fields. Brian discussed tire tracks that were left on the field which need to be repaired before practices can continue. His club lines and maintains the fields.

- **Drug Alliance** Presentation of "My Place" film presented by Helen Varvi. Film about underage teenage drinking. Parents need to know where their children are and who they are with. Need to give kids safe alternatives. Join the "Safe Homes" program. A program to encourage open communication and positive peer pressure among parents with the goal of preventing underage drinking and drug use. Soccer community interested in showing film at a meeting. Steroids drug testing also discussed. Handout was giving.

- **Summer Rec. update**  
Handout was given. Gary Conk (not present) concerned about staffing for summer recreation. If he loses a top tier counselor can a top tier counselor be hired for replacement or does he hire a lower tier? Can counselors hired from last year, be moved up a tier this year? Salary budget needs to be set under the salary cap. Art supplies need to be ordered, approximately \$3,000.00 as last year supplies were from the previous year.
- **Concussing in sports:**  
C/Kinsey discussed teaching Children proper way to protect their heads in sport activities. Need to know the signs that a child has a concussion. Have an awareness package given to coaches. Missing AED from the middle school discussed. Will we replace or will the school replace. Need to decide where AED is needed on the soccer fields and how to secure.
- **Lacrosse update:**  
A discussion took place regarding the current boys that are waitlisted for Lacrosse. Since we are recreation no child should be turned away. All children are on a team and all the needed coaches were secured. Discussion took place about advancing the money so referees can be paid at the game. Further discussing needs to take place.
- **Basketball season update**  
Season has ended – successful season-kids had a good time. Evaluation system discussed
- **Spring soccer** – no report
- **Tennis** – non-resident signup approved.
- **Code of conduct**  
Barred for one year from any recreation sponsored event, Spectator or coach. Township Attorney will send out letter before name will available. How do we enforce the ban of said person?
- **Wagner Farm Park update**  
Security system not functioning. Heat in building needs to be lowered.
- **Abate Park**  
Courts being sealed, seeding to being in a couple of weeks, once weather stays warm.
- **Community Map**  
Currently at the printer. Approximately \$9000.00
- **AED (*Automated External Defibrillator*)** Discussed earlier.
- **Men's Softball**  
C/Dorfman advised program needs players, will advertise on the PEG channel and newspaper. Season to start the end of April, lasting approximately 8-10 weeks.

- **Bowling league approved**, unanimous. Any sport added to the program is an asset. There would be no cost to the town and Brunswick Lanes would incur the fee for the flyers and would deliver the flyers to the school. This is a pay as you play program, recreation does not administration this program.
