

**MILLSTONE TOWNSHIP PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION  
MEETING MINUTES**

C/Dorfman opened the meeting to the public at 8:02 PM

**Scott Keleher** (38 Hampton Hollow Drive, Perrieneville, NJ 08535) proposed to the Commission an eagle scout project he is interested in doing. The project he discussed is a bulletin board which would be installed at the Brandywine soccer fields. The bulletin board would be made of wood and Plexiglas and would have flowers planted around the base. C/Kinsey stated the project needs to be similar to the bulletin boards in the other Township Parks so there is continuity. The commission advised they will discuss the project and if approved, he can then do a formal presentation. S. Keleher's eighteenth birthday will be April 20, 2011.

***AGENDA ITEMS:***

- **Teen Night**

C/Murphy stated he was scheduled to chaperone last week's teen night, but the primary school gym was locked when he arrived. He waited until 8:20, no participants showed, so he left. It was stated by Diane Keleher (public) that once spring school sports begin, some programs practice on Friday nights and could be why no one attended. She suggested ending teen night at the end of March.

- **Basketball**  
Short discussion took place in regards to the “round robin tournament” that took place at the last game of the season. It was stated the tournament should take place over two days rather than one day as some teams played three games in a row.

C/Kinsey stated the wrestling program was honored with a title from the Grapevine Wrestling Organization and will be presented with a trophy. C/Kinsey suggested he would contact the BOE and inquire if we could display our trophy for one year, in their trophy case located in the Middle school.

- **Wagner Farm Park / Abate Park / Brandywine / Rocky Brook Park**  
C/Klehr discussed the tennis courts at Rocky Brook Park have been cleared of leaves and debris and were power washed by the Dept of Public works, but need to be maintained throughout the year as there are many trees that surround the courts. The parking lot is in the process of being paved and curbing. The porta potty has also been delivered.  
  
Graffiti on the newly installed bathrooms at Abate Park was mentioned; C/Kinsey stated it will be cleaned off shortly. The bathroom is still being installed and should be ready for use by mid May. A discussion also took place in regards to the need of a shade cover somewhere on the tennis courts as there are no large trees in park to provide shade.
  
- **Spring Instructional Soccer**  
Enrollment down slightly from last year, start of the season is this coming Saturday.
  
- **Summer Rec**  
A short discussion took place in regards to the BOE charging the program to utilize the Primary School on Fridays during July.
  
- **Millstone Day 2009**  
C/Hanson stated he and C/Ricci took a tour of Blackbear camp grounds for consideration of holding the event at that facility. C/Hanson stated he feels it may be wise to alternate years between the two camps to give the event a different feel from year to year. After a discussion, the commission agreed it would be in our best interest to keep the event at Frogbridge as it’s a larger facility with more available parking. C/Hanson stated he would contact Frogbridge and request a date for Millstone Day 2009.
