**MAYOR KINSEY CALLS THE REGULAR MEETING TO ORDER AT 8:16 P.M.

PRESENTATION: Chaz Garrity - SwiftReach Networks, Inc.

Mr. Garrity discusses SwiftReach Networks communications system. Swift911 solution integrates emergency alerting, lockdown (SLIM) incident management, public contact registration and 9-1-1 lookup.

Alerting - utilizes voice, text, email, fax, pager, social media - supports over 40 languages and text to speech, every member of the community has the opportunity (at no fee) to receive and understand the message.

Lockdown - this component speeds incident response time and accuracy. Using lockdown (SLIM) incident commanders and first responders can view and manage real-time tactical information through any computer or mobile device. Building occupants can trigger lockdowns and communicate directly with law enforcement.

Public contact - Swift911 can import existing data from sources such as flat-files, ESL/ANI/ALI files. Contact data can be collected and reconciled through the Swift911 Opt-in portal, they can also supply current listed contact data to the municipality.

9-1-1 Lookup - provides enhanced data (including identities of mobile callers) to your 911
