COMMENTS FROM THE DAIS:

C/Grbelja discusses the traffic in town, we have had residents volunteer for our safety awareness campaign. C/Grbelja has identified at least 6 dangerous spots in the town, we will continue to gather additional information, assess the situation and put together a committee by August.

C/Masci speaks about the back up of traffic along Burnt Tavern Road and County Route 537 going to Great Adventure. We need to place mobile devices (speed detectors) around town that may help with speeders, we had one which is now broken.

M/Kinsey states that he recently went to the Conference of Mayors and has spoken with vendors

regarding solar speed detectors. M/Kinsey has spoken with Dan Specht, DPW Coordinator, who has reached out to the vendor.

C/Dorfman speaks about an incident where a landscaper pulled out of a driveway on Sweetmans Lane, with a trailer that almost caused an accident.

C/Grbelja also states that there has been a problem on Prodelin Way with dump trucks.

C/Masci states we should have zero tolerance when it comes to the dump truck coming from the mines.

C/Grbelja speaks about the lawsuit between Millstone Township Board of Education and Upper Freehold Board of Education and states the Judge has denied the lawsuit.

M/Kinsey states that he went to the meeting that Dr. Feder held on June 21, 2016, and that the school board was right to defend lawsuit.
