BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Millstone, County of

Monmouth, State of New Jersey, as follows: (additions are <u>underlined</u>, and deletions are in

[brackets]:

I

Chapter II, Administration, Section 2-45, Payment to Township, is hereby deleted in its

entirety and replaced with the following:

2-45 PAYMENT TO TOWNSHIP.

a. All payments to the Township shall be by personal or business check or credit card. The

Township shall not accept cash for payment of any obligations owed to the Township by any

person or entity.

b. In the event that any person or entity shall remit any payment to the Township by

personal or business check or credit card, which is dishonored by the financial institution on which

the check was written or through whom the credit card is processed, all future payments to the

Township shall be by certified check, treasurers check or money order for a period of one (1) year.

c. Any charges to the Township for payments that are dishonored by any financial

institution or credit card company shall be reimbursed by the person or entity remitting such

payment.

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

## <u>III</u>

If any section, subparagraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such decision shall not invalidate the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

## $\overline{\mathbf{IV}}$

This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication according to law.

**EXPLANATORY STATEMENT:** This Ordinance provides that all payments made to the Township shall be made by check or credit card and that no cash will be accepted as payment of any obligation owed to the Township.
