  individuals representing Millstone Township and file an annual
  accomplishment report at the end of the year to regain compliance for 2021.

- Arbor Day 2021 Scott and Bruce will donate trees and will ask other nursey owners to donate a few other trees.
- We will plant a tree at the Millstone Township building and another tree at the middle school.
