He feels he is being unfairly targeted for the past nine months. He has received multiple summonses for salt being stored in his driveway and for a registered trailer that has a business sign on it. He has been asked to remove the trailer within 10 days or he will receive a possible fine of up to \$2,000.00. Today, he met with the Business Administrator and Code Enforcement regarding his summons. There was an incident that occurred and he felt threatened by the Business Administrator.

Attorney Munoz said that the incident with the Business Administrator is under investigation and can't be discussed.

DM/Grbelja said she has been on the Township Committee and Planning Board since 2004 and has been instrumental in creating some of the ordinances that guide our municipality. DM/Grbelja addressed the sign ordinance and some of the issues that have occurred with businesses that were in violation of the ordinance. DM/Grbelja explained that over the years the Township has worked with residents and home businesses so that so that they can be successful. As the Township continues to grow, they are adhering to the ordinances. The Township will review and possibly revise the sign ordinance on how they relate to small businesses.

Joseph Buffa said he respects everything DM/Grbelja said. Please help the small businesses, you are my neighbors.

DM/Grbelja closes the meeting to the public at 8:2 pm.
