**WHEREAS**, N.J.A.C. 2:76-17A.6 requires municipalities to submit annual applications to the Farmland Preservation Program Municipal Planning Incentive Grant to be eligible to receive funding; and

**WHEREAS,** N.J.A.C. 2:76-17A.6(a)2iii(3) requires Municipal Planning Incentive Grant applications be accompanied by a resolution of support from the Governing Body; and

**WHEREAS**, the Millstone Township Committee has determined that it is in the best interests of the Township to maintain a robust farmland preservation program, to continue to access funds from the SADC's Municipal PIG program, and to acquire as many farmland preservation easements from eligible farms, in partnership with the SADC and the County of Monmouth, as possible; and

**WHEREAS,** Millstone Township's Agriculture Advisory Council recommends that the Township continue to participate in the SADC's Municipal PIG program.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of Millstone Township, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that it endorses and supports the submission of the Millstone Township Farmland Preservation Municipal Planning Incentive Grant Program 2025 Planning Round Application to the SADC.
