EXPLANATORY STATEMENT: This Ordinance revision provides for amendments to the bulk standards of the permitted municipally sponsored affordable housing use in the BP Zone to increase the permitted height of multi-family buildings from 2 stories / 30 feet to 3 stories / 40 feet. This revision is due to the change in programing for the proposed development at 27 Burnt Tavern Road. The development was approved by Court in 2023 as part of an amended Housing Element and Fair Share Plan that increased the number of affordable units on this site from 49 units to 66 (plus one additional unit for a property manager). Because of the increase in units and further exploration into the environmental constraints on the site, the required building massing has changed.
