Premiere at Monmouth University's Pollak Theater is open to the public

FREEHOLD, NJ – As this week marks the 10th Anniversary of Superstorm Sandy's landfall, Monmouth County Clerk Christine Giordano Hanlon is pleased to announce the premiere of *The Jersey Storm: Sandy in Monmouth County* film will take place this Fri., Oct. 28 at 1:30 p.m. at the Pollak Theater at Monmouth University and is open to the public to attend. The 20-minute historical documentary will be presented as part of Monmouth University's Superstorm Sandy 10th Anniversary events.

In addition to this month marking the 10th Anniversary of the storm, October is also American Archives Month, which calls attention to the importance of archiving historically significant information.

The premiere of the film on Fri., Oct. 28 at Monmouth University’s Pollak Theater at 1:30 p.m. is open to the public. Reservation is not required.
