County Clerk Hanlon Reminds Voters of the Three Ways to Vote in the 2022 General Election

More Ways to Vote, More Days to Vote!

FREEHOLD, NJ – Monmouth County Clerk Christine Giordano Hanlon is reminding residents of the three options for voting in the 2022 General Election.

Voters may cast their ballots early in-person at one of the County's 10 designated early voting locations from Oct. 29 through Nov. 6. Voters can also choose to vote traditionally on Election Day, Nov. 8, or to vote by mail.

"We are fortunate to have three convenient ways to cast our ballots here in New Jersey," said Clerk Hanlon. "Voting by mail, early, or on Election Day are all safe and secure ways to cast your ballot in the General Election."

Voters can choose to vote early in-person on machines at any of the 10 designated early voting polling locations in Monmouth County, from Saturday, Oct. 29 through Sunday, Nov. 6. The early voting hours are Monday through Saturday from 10 a.m. to

8 p.m., and Sundays from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. The list of designated polling locations can be found on the MonmouthCountyVotes.com website. Voters can cast their ballots at any of the 10 designated polling locations, regardless of where they live within the County.

As always, voters have the option to vote the traditional way on Election Day, Nov. 8. Voters can cast their ballots on machines at their assigned polling locations. The polls will be open from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. and voters can find their polling locations at MonmouthCountyVotes.com.

Voters can also choose to vote by Mail-In Ballot. In order to do so, a Vote by Mail Ballot Application must be submitted to the County Clerk. Applications can be obtained from MonmouthCountyVotes.com, the County Clerk's Monmouth County Votes Mobile App, or by visiting the County Clerk's Elections Office at 300 Halls Mills Road in Freehold.

Applications to Vote by Mail that are sent by U.S. Mail must be received by the County Clerk's Office seven days before the election. Voters may apply in-person at the County Clerk's Elections Office located at 300 Halls Mill Road in Freehold up until 3 p.m. on Nov. 7.

Completed ballots can be returned for counting either by mail or in-person at the Board of Elections Office at 300 Halls Mills Road, or to one of the County's ballot drop box locations. Drop box locations can be found at MonmouthCountyVotes.com.
